

TEEN TAAL TUKRA

In Teen Taal, a tukra is a short, rhythmic composition that serves as a standalone piece within the taal cycle. Composed of various tabla syllables (or bols), tukras are often intricate, creating a distinct, lively rhythm within the structure of Teen Taal's 16 beats. Tukras typically conclude with a tihai—a phrase repeated three times to end precisely on the sam (the first beat of the cycle).
