- In the Thumri, the tabla subtly marks the Deepchandi Taal (14 beats), enhancing the romantic mood.
- In the Bhajan, it gently keeps Keharwa Taal (8 beats), steady and meditative.

The percussion here does not overpower but embraces the melody.
